with interest thereon from this 22nd day of Dec 1922 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Fifty dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said mortgagor
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said mortgagor
W.R. Neely in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.R. Neely, his heirs and assigns,

Witness my hand and seal
All of my right, title, and undivided one-half in-
terest of and to all that certain piece, parcel or
lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of
South Carolina, and County of Greenville, on the Paris
Mountain Road, and having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on the Paris Mountain Road,
corner of H. W. Batson's land and running thence
with said Road N. 51 1/2 E. 395 feet to a stone; thence
N. 41 3/4 W. 475 feet to a stake on J. E. Beattie's line; thence
with Beattie's line S. 43 W. 395 feet to a stake on
Batson's line; thence with Batson's line S. 41 3/4 E. 416
feet to the beginning corner, and containing 4 acres,
more or less; this is the same land conveyed to
me and H. C. Nix by deed dated 1st day of Dec. 1917
and recorded in the R. M. C. for Greenville County, S. C.
in Vol. # 25 of Deeds, at page 388.

This is a second mortgage on my interest in the
above described premises; J. M. Andred holds the first
