in County and State aforesaid: Beginning at an iron pin in a cross, found by the Jordan
and Wingo-Mosteller Roads, at Riller Browns corner and runs thence with the Wingo-
Mostellar Road to a point to center of said road where it intersects G.W. Howells line
to a point in center of Jordan Road; thence with the Jordan Road to the beginning corner,
containing a boundary unsurveyed supposed to contain about two acres, adjoining lands of
G.W. Howell, Riller Brown and myself and is a part of tract of 86.30 acres, deeded me
Jan. 25, 1918 by Loula M. Briggs and recorded in Vol. 50, at page 31, R.M.C. for said
