SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, O. H. Schwiers, the said Promisor
in and by my certain note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

H. K. Townes (Attorney)
in the full and just sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00)
Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Semi-annually in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. K. Townes, Attorney, his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece parcel and lot of land, situate in the
state and county aforesaid near the city of Greenville,
adjoining lands of John Curton, Robert Adams and others
and being known as part of the Dickson Annex and being
described as follows:

Beginning on a stone Harrisons corner, and running thence
N. 63 1/4 E. 210 feet to an iron pin in road; thence N. 10 E.
257 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63 1/4 W. 210 feet to a pin
on Harrisons line; thence with said line S. 10 W. 257 feet to
the beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less and
being the same land conveyed to me by Henry Schwiers, by
