until paid in full; and if all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by this note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

The above described lot has a frontage of 66 feet on Chandler St. and runs back in parallel lines 150 feet, being the same lot conveyed to me by R. M. Covil.
