I, George W. Brown SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, George W. Brown  
in and by H.P. McGee certain Promissory note in writing, of

even date with these presents, H.P. McGee and C.M. McGee, Trustees  
well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of twenty-five hundred  
Dollars, to be paid on or before June 29th 1922

with interest thereon from June 29th 1920 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to be interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, George W. Brown  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.P. McGee and C.M. McGee, Trustees their heirs and assigns

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the County and  
State aforesaid in the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville and having the  
following metes and bounds to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Green Avenue and Arlington Avenue and  
running thence along Arlington Avenue N. 71 W. 203 feet; thence N. 28 E. 94 feet to corner  
of lot O.O. Allen; thence along line of said lot S. 64 1/2 E. 197 feet to a point on  
Green Avenue; thence along with Green Avenue S. 71-3/4 E. 72 feet 9 inches to the beginning  
corner; this being Lot No. 1 and the front-half of lot No. 8 of the subdivision of  
the land of St. Paul Methodist, see plat A. page 140 R.M.C. Office of Greenville County.
