with interest thereon from Jan. 1st, 1923 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

100 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.G. Mock, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the
East side of Westfield St., and having following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stake 3xom on said Street and running thence with said Street North 20-1/2
E. 92-1/2 ft. to a stake 3x in middle of a 12 foot alley; thence S. 69-1/2 E. 147 ft. along
the middle of alley to a stake 3xom; thence South 10 West 93 ft. to the middle of a well;
thence North 69-1/2 West 165 ft. to the beginning corner on Westfield St., and being the same
lot of land conveyed to me by the Greenville Real Estate Loan and Insurance Company by
