computed and paid annually

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Bessie Gray for and  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A.C. Davis, All my interest, same being an undivided one-third

interest, in all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the  
City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, in Ward 5 of said City being on the East  
side of Brockman Street: Beginning at a stake on Brockman St. at corner of lot No. 2,  
running along said Street S. 12-1/2 W. 70 feet to a stake; thence S. 77-1/2 E. 90 feet to a stake;  
thence N. 12-1/2 E. 70 feet to a stake; thence N. 77-1/2 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner and  
known as lot No. 3, on plat of Belton Wood lot made by J.R. Lawrence March 9th, 1906  
Being the same lot conveyed to my husband William Gray by Belton Woods and recorded in Vol. 3,  
W. at page 488 office of R.M.C. for Greenville County.
