with interest thereon from date of the note eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually Frank H. Earle

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frank H. Earle, his heirs and assigns,

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate just outside the corporate limits of the
City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, known as Lots Nos. 8 and 9 in Block E. in
plat of survey of land of W.M. Norwood known as Norwood Heights, made by W.D. Neves, Surveyor
bearing date of March 1920, and recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat
Book E., pages 215 and 216, and being the same lots conveyed to me by W.M. Norwood by deed
dated December 27th, 1921 and recorded in Volume 73, page 363, R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County. Said lots together front on Vance Street 50 feet and run through to the P. & N.
right-of-way a distance of 150 feet.

This mortgage is contemporaneous with mortgage executed to J.K. Earle, Agent for Two Hundred
fifty (\$250.00) Dollars on same land.
