Dollars, to be paid \$100.00 Feb. 1st. 1923; \$100.00 Aug. 1st. 1923; \$100.00 Feb. 1st. 1924; \$100.00 Aug. 1st. 1924; \$100.00 Feb. 1st. 1925; \$100.00 Aug. 1st. 1925

with interest thereon from August 1st. 1922 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually
