

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WE, William and Martha Lark, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said William and Martha Lark in and by my certain bond or obligation, bearing date the 11th day of April 1922, stand firmly held and bound unto THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the penal sum of Twenty-four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars, conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 11th day of April A. D. 1922 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of said Company, in manner and form the following, that is to say, that we the said William and Martha Lark shall pay, or cause to be paid, to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors, or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th day, or before the end of the month of April 1922, and on the 20th, or before the end of each month thereafter, for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty + 20/100 (\$20.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Twelve shares of stock, and Eight + 20/100 (\$8.00) Dollars being the monthly interest on the advance or loan), until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eighteen + 40/100 (\$18.40) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Six + 40/100 (\$6.40) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Fourteen + 40/100 (\$14.40) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four + 80/100 (\$4.80) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifteen + 20/100 (\$15.20) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three + 20/100 (\$3.20) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Thirteen + 60/100 (\$13.60) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One + 60/100 (\$1.60) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due).

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th, or before the last day, of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Twelve shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid on the said shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said William and Martha Lark and shall pay or cause to be paid, all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said William and Martha Lark in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said bond or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said William and Martha Lark in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said bond or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to us the said William and Martha Lark in hand well and truly paid by the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Situate on the east side of Calhoun Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the East side of Calhoun Street 326 feet from the northeast corner of Calhoun and Dunbar Streets, and running thence with Calhoun Street N. 18 E. 52 feet to a stake; thence S. 76 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence S. 18 W. 52 feet to a stake; thence N. 76 W. 200 feet to a stake on Calhoun Street, the beginning corner, and known and designated as Lot No. 17 on plat recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book WW, page 605, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Margaret H. Beattie, Executrix of the Estate of H.C. Beattie, deceased by deed to be recorded.
