in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nora B. McDaniel

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about four miles South of Greenville Courthouse on the Old Augusta Road, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at stone on old Augusta Road; thence S. 67-1/2 W. 14.00 to stone; thence S. 58-1/2 E. 41 links to stone; thence N. 75-1/2 E. 13.50 to stone on road; thence N. 10 W. 2.21 to the beginning corner, containing One and three-fourths acres, more or less. Being the same conveyed to me by Mary White McCrary by deed dated March 22, 1923.
