in hand well and truly paid of and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie Moss

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Fairview

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina located opposite the Keever Public School Grounds and

having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the branch and running thence N. 29-1/2 E. 36.50 chains to center of public road, corner of said school lot; thence along road S. 60-1/2 E. 8.34 chains to center of road; thence S. 33-1/2 W. 20 chains to a stone; thence S. 60-1/2 E. 5 chains to a stone; thence S. 31-1/2 W. 14.30 chains to center of branch; thence N. 69-3/4 W. down said branch 12.25 chains to the beginning corner, and containing 35 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands now or formerly of E.B.
