all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 27 on plat of property of J.R. Yown, made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, in May 1923, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat: Beginning at a stake at the intersection of White Horse and Anderson Roads and running thence with the Anderson Road N. 38-55 E. 334.4 feet to a stake corner of lot No. 24; thence with line of said lot N. 26-30 W. 169.7 feet to iron pin corner of lot No. 26; thence with line of said lot S. 62-20 W. 281.2 feet to stake in center of White Horse Road; thence with White Horse Road S. 22-25 E. 304.7 feet to the beginning, containing 1.53 acres, more or less, being a part of the same conveyed to me by Julia D.-Charles, Tr., by deed dated October 10th, 1923 and this mortgage is given to secure the payment of the purchase price of said lot.

Also that lot of land in the Township, State and County aforesaid, near the Judson Mills, being known and designated as Lot No. 14 on plat of J.O. Heatherly property recorded in Plat Book E, page 238, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat: Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of the Judson Road, corner of lot No. 13 and running thence with said road S. 3-36 W. 104.7 feet to stake at point in road; thence still with said road S. 52-39 E. 49 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 15; thence in a north-easterly direction with line of lot No. 15, 100 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 13; thence in a north-westerly direction 93 feet, more or less, to beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Julia D.
