the City of Greenville, more particularly described as follows: Beginning on Hampton Avenue  
at corner of lot conveyed by W.E. Phelps to Eliza T. Looper, and running thence with Hampton  
Avenue N. 62-1/2 W. 57 feet to Barr's corner; thence with Barr's line N. 25-3/4 E. 79 feet;
