in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Florence R. Crinkshaw, Mrs. Carrie C. McGee and Mrs. Ella C. Walker all that piece parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the City of Greenville, on the South side of Hampton Avenue (formerly Highland Avenue), fronting on said Hampton Avenue 65 feet and running back 700 feet adjoining property of St. Mary's Catholic School Heriwood place and of Charles and being part of lot conveyed to Julia D.
