In West Greenville on the South side of a twelve-foot  
 alley leading eastward from Bob street, and having  
 the following courses and distances according  
 to Survey made by B. H. Millard, Engineer, April  
 1924: Beginning at an iron pipe in the center of  
 said twelve-foot alley 105 feet east of Bob street  
 and running thence with line of other property  
 of Glaudie Bartton S. 22° W. 135.02 feet to iron pipe;  
 thence S. 67° 30' E. 58.5 feet to a fence post, thence  
 N. 22° 45' E. 135 feet to stake in center of said alley;  
 thence with said alley N. 67° 30' W. 60 feet to the beginning.  
 It is understood and agreed that the lien of this  
 mortgage is junior to that of a mortgage for
