(3) A tract to contain ten acres, to be laid off so as to include the dwelling of said mortgagor; said tract is to be as nearly square as possible. its Western or South-Western boundary is to be the Greenville and Western Railway; its northern or North-Western boundary is to be a four acre "hotel lot" belonging to Mrs. Elizabeth M.
