WHEREAS, We, the said W.P. Golightly and M.F. Golightly

Dollars, to be paid April 12, 1923

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at
any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon
and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this
mortgage in the hands of an attorney for legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including
10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said A.D.L. Barksdale, All that certain lot of land in Greenville

Township, near the eastern limits of the City of Greenville, in the section known as
Overbrook, being lot No. 50 on the plat made by H.Olin Jones, and according to said plat
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone on North Street, joint corner of lots #49 and #50 and running thence
S. 9-28 E. 330 feet to a stake on alley; thence along alley N. 73-47 E. 75 feet to a
stake; thence N. 8-30 W. 327.2 feet to a stake on North Street; thence along North Street
S. 76-07 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.
