WHEREAS, I, W. D. Workman, the said W. D. Workman SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, to be paid One year after date

with interest thereon from this day of May 1927 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, W. D. Workman in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Jas. M. Richardson according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said W. D. Workman in hand, well and truly paid by the said Jas. M. Richardson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jas. M. Richardson, his heirs and assigns

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid being known and designated as Lot No. 21. on plat of property of Rush Bros made by R. C. Dalton Engr. January 1924 and being described according to said plat as follows: Beginning at a point on the North side of Beucaube Street joint corner of Lots Nos 20 and 21, and running thence along line of Lot No. 20 and 14 N. 20-04 E. 67.8 feet to point joint corner of Lots 14 and 21 thence along West North Street N. 69-07 W. 29.95 feet to drill hole on Richardson Street thence with Richardson Street S. 18-57 W. 47.45 feet to drill hole corner of Richardson and Beucaube Streets thence with Beucaube Street S. 34-30 E. 35.66 feet to drill hole the beginning corner this being one of the lots conveyed to me by J. N. Rush. It is understood that this mortgage is junior in rank to a certain mortgage executed by W. D. Workman to J. N. Rush in the sum of \$12,000.00
