WHEREAS, I, John L. Plyler, the said John L. Plyler SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Five hundred + no/100 (\$500.00)

Dollars, to be paid May 10th, 1925

with interest thereon from date of maturity at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at
any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon
and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before
its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this
mortgage in the hands of an attorney for the legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including
10 percent of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this
mortgage as a part of said debt.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph R. Bryson

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying
and being on the North side of Buicombe Street, City of
Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the
following metes and bounds, to wit:-
Beginning at the corner of lot owned by Beattie, now or
formerly, and running thence along the line of said
lot 148 ft. more or less, thence in a Northerly direction
52 ft. along line parallel with Buicombe Street; thence 148
ft. more or less, parallel with the above mentioned Beattie's
lot to a point on Buicombe Street; thence along said Buic-
combe Street 52 ft. to a beginning point. Being the same lot of
land conveyed to me by Joseph R. Bryson, this mortgage be-
ing given to secure a portion of the purchase price.
