WHEREAS, I, Allen J. Graham, the said Allen J. Graham

in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of  
 even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to George Norwood

in the full and just sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid Two (2) years after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
 computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at  
 any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon  
 and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before  
 its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this  
 mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including  
 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this  
 mortgage as a part of said debt.

 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said George Norwood

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
 bargain, sell and release unto the said George Norwood

All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying  
 and being at Paris Station, in the County and  
 State aforesaid, and having according to a plat made  
 by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, which is recorded in R. M. C.  
 Office in Plat Book "F", page 231, the following metes  
 and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe in right of way of Southern  
 Railway Company's main line tracks 4 feet 6 inches  
 North of North bound track, and running thence along  
 a road 74.32 feet to an iron pipe on edge of paved drive,  
 thence S. 58 W. 719.9 feet to an iron pin 4 feet 6 inches  
 North of North bound track of the main line of the  
 Southern Railway Company; thence N. 58-03 E, 719.9 feet  
 to an iron pipe, the point of beginning.

Together with all the rights and privileges which  
 were granted to Allen J. Graham and H. S. Bradley by deed  
 of James W. Langford dated October 1st, 1920 and  
 this deed is subject to all the reservations and re-  
 strictions and limitations set out in said deed.
