Dollars, to be paid One hundred fifty (\$150.00) Dollars July 1, 1925, one hundred fifty (\$150.00) Dollars July 1, 1926, One hundred fifty (\$150.00) Dollars July 1, 1927, One hundred fifty (\$150.00) Dollars July 1, 1928, Six hundred sixty-two (\$662.00) Dollars July 1, 1929

with interest thereon from July 1, 1924 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually
