with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the whole amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind or if any part of the money due on said note be not paid when due (and of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Home Builders Company, a Corporation, the following described real estate: "All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and on the South side of Monticello Ave. and being known and designated as Lot No. 118 of "Glenn Grove Park", as shown by a sub-division and plat of same made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer in May 1924, which plat is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 233, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by said plat, to-wit:
