until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of twenty five dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Mortgagor
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Mortgagor

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Brooks Thompson, and his heirs and assigns

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying
and being in the State and county aforesaid, in Fairbairn
Mountain Township, near the White Horse Road, and
containing 15 acres more or less, adjoining lands of
McNabb, Lipscomb et al. and having such metes and
bounds as are shown in a deed made to me by
Mamie Pool which deed is dated Oct. 18th. 1918 and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.
in Vol. #51 of Deeds, at page 225, to which deed reference
is made.
