WHEREAS, I, the said W.O. Gosnell

in the full and just sum of two hundred and forty-three (243.00)
Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$121.50 January 1st, 1923 and \$121.50 January 1st, 1924

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said mortgagor
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

mortgagee
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

mortgagor
in hand well and truly paid by the said

mortgagee
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.D. Trammell, and his heirs and assigns, All those pieces,

parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, at
Paris Station, on the National Highway, and having the following metes and bounds,
according to a plat of a subdivision of land of J.D. Trammell, made by R.E. Dalton, Engr.
August 1917, said plat is recorded in plat book E, at page 66, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin, corner of a street and the National Highway, and running thence
along said Highway N. 55-42 E. 40 feet to an iron pipe, W.A. Williams corner; thence
along said Williams line N. 37-47 W. 105 feet to corner of Lot #4; thence approximately
N. 55-42 W. 40 feet to a point on a Street; thence with said Street S. 37-47 E. 105
feet to the beginning corner, and being known as Lots #11, 12 and a portion of land
adjoining said two lots in the rear; these being the same lots of land conveyed to me by
J.D. Trammell by deed dated 7th, day of Feby. 1922, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office
for said County and State in Volume #62 of Deeds, at page 454, to which deed and plat
reference is made.
