I, Mrs. Belle Tollison of Greenville County, S.C.

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Mrs. Belle Tollison in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers and Merchants Bank of Greenville, South Carolina in the full and just sum of One Hundred and ninety Dollars, to be paid ninety days after in full

with interest thereon from maturity of said note at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid quarterly in advance until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Mrs. Belle Tollison in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Farmers and Merchants Bank according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Mrs. Belle Tollison in hand well and truly paid by the said Farmers and Merchants Bank

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers and Merchants Bank, of Greenville, South

Carolina the following described piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township, being situated about two miles from Greenville Courthouse, in the subdivision known as Pendleton Heights, and shown on plat made by W.D. Neves in December 1912 and designated on said plat as Lot number twelve thereof and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:- Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Gentry Street six hundred twenty-five feet from the North side of the Pendleton Road and running thence with Gentry Street in a northeasterly direction fifty feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot number fourteen in a Northwesterly direction one hundred fifty feet to an iron pin; thence in a southwesterly direction parallel with Gentry Street fifty feet to an iron pin; thence in a southwesterly direction, with the line of lot number Ten, one hundred fifty feet to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land heretofore conveyed to Belle Tollison by deed of Wm.C. Sistine dated December 5, 1921, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for said County and State in Deed Book 62, at page 372 thereof, reference to which deed is hereby made in aid of and as a part of this description.
