NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, the said Maudie Burton for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Maudie Burton according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said William Burton in hand well and truly paid by the said Maudie Burton at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Maudie Burton:

That certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about five (5) miles northwest of the Town of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone in the line of Lands of William Burton, at the corner of Lot No. 1 and running thence S. 52 1/2 W. 1250 feet to a stone; thence S. 29 1/8 E. 206 feet to a stone; thence N. 58 1/2 E. 934 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11 1/4 E. 462 feet to the beginning corner, and being Lot No. Five of a subdivision of the Estate of Orionus Burton, made by H.
