Stokes at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Ruth M. Stokes, her

heirs and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land containing one hundred twenty four and four-tenths acres, (124.4) situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, County of Greenville, S.C., and bounded as follows: north by lands of Davenport, East by J. E. Knight, south by lands of Knight and Haugh, and west by Haugh and possibly others.

This being the same tract of land allotted to me as an heir a law in the partition of the estate lands of my mother, Mrs. F. C. Stokes.
