(2) acres, more or less, described and bounded as follows:
On the East by center of Rail Road track (P & N), on the
South by lands of *W. Munroe Allen*; on the West by
center of Hard surfaced Highway and *Bennett*
lands and the north by lands of the said *C. H.*
Bennett. Being the same lot of land conveyed
