NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said H. G. Tooley
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

E. L. Wilson and A. L. Wilson note according to the terms
 of the said..... and also in consideration of

the further sum of Three Dollars to me, the said H. G. Tooley
 in hand well and truly paid by the said E. L. Wilson and A. L. Wilson

at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by
 these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said E. L. Wilson and A. L. Wilson
 the following described real estate, to-wit:-

1. All those two lots of land situate in the County of Spartaburg,
 State of South Carolina, in Beech Springs Township near the Town of
 Isser on the north side of Appaloosa Street, designated as Lots #13 and #14 on
 a plat of land called "Dillworth Park", and having the following metes and bounds: Be-
 ginning at intersection of Appaloosa and Moss Streets and runs thence with Moss St.
 N. 32-58 E. 200 feet; thence S. westward 122.5 feet to corner of lot #12; thence along line of lot
 No. 12 S. 32-58 E. 212 feet to Appaloosa St; thence along this street N. 54-27 E. 130 feet to the begin-
 ning corner. Said lots being in Block "C" on said plat and are the same lots conveyed
 to John J. Tooley by S. B. Bruce by deed dated March 9th 1922 and recorded in Book 6-0
 page 203. Also: All that tract or lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of
 South Carolina on branch waters of Beaver Creek and having the following metes & bounds:
 Beginning on a stone on old line division corner between H. P. Gibson and J. J. Tooley
 and runs thence S. 28³/₄ E. 11.79 chs. to a stone 0 M; thence S. 5³/₄ E. 6.16 chs. to a stone; thence
 S. 42 E. 20.80 chs. to a stake near the branch; thence N. 23 W. 25.41 chs. to a stone, 0 M;
 thence N. 63³/₄ E. 19.46 chs. to the beginning corner containing 42³/₁₀ acres, more or
 less, and the same tract of land conveyed to J. J. Tooley by H. P. Gibson in deed
 bearing date March 18, 1901 and recorded in the office of A. M. C. for
 Greenville County in Vol. 555 at page 841.

It is further understood and agreed that the said mortgagor
