TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Charlie W. Cox

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said Charlie W. Cox, Unmarried  
am well and truly indebted to Troyon Federal Savings and Loan Association,

Inc. in the full and just sum of one Thousand  
Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1753.00) Dollars,  
to be paid in monthly installments of \$20.00  
on the first day of each succeeding month, be-  
ginning on the first day of September, 1939, and  
continuing until all indebtedness shall have been  
paid in full. The principal is to bear interest  
from date until paid at 6% per annum and  
each payment is to be credited first on the  
payment of the interest then due on the effective  
debt, and thereafter credited on the principal.  
The above described indebtedness is evidenced by  
a cash promissory note of even date herewith,  
which also provides for attorney fees in the  
event of collection by an attorney in the suit, all of which by  
reference being unto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Charlie W. Cox, unmarried  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Troyon

Federal Savings and Loan Association, Inc. according to the terms  
of the said note #5119 and also in consideration of

the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said Charlie W. Cox, unmarried  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Troyon Federal Savings and Loan Association, Inc.  
at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by  
these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Troyon Federal Savings and Loan

Association, its successors and assigns forever: all  
that lot, piece or parcel of land in the County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and de-  
signated as Lot Number 62 of Plat Number 1 of the  
property of the Troyon Development Company, known  
as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C. E., and  
duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds  
Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book Num-  
ber "Page"; Being lot No. 62 of the Holmes Hill  
Lot Section of Lake Lanier Development as shown  
on the Plat of same, being duly recorded in the  
records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
and lot being bound by the following lines:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Lake  
Shore Drive at a distance of 2,206.0 feet more or  
less from its intersection with the Troyon-Spartan-  
burg Highway, said point being exactly 10.8 feet  
southward from the beginning of a circular curve  
with a radius of 150.0 feet, said beginning of curve  
being duly referenced by two concrete monuments as  
shown on aforesaid plat, and running thence along  
the said center line a distance of 39.0 feet, thence  
along a line drawn radial to the said curve to the  
first street east of Lake Shore Drive a distance of  
169.0 feet more or less, thence Northward along the  
center line of said street to a point of intersection  
of said street with a line drawn to aforesaid curve  
from the point of the beginning of this description  
a distance of about 85.0 feet; thence along the said
