and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on Watson Avenue, adjoining lots of Mr. Thackston and Dr. William J. Langston, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin, corner of lot of Mr. Thackston and runs thence S. 71 W. 125 feet with line of Thackston lot to an iron pin; thence N. 18 W. 55 feet to iron pin, corner of lot sold to Dr. W.J. Langston; thence N. 71 E. 125 feet with line of lot of W.J.
