SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Mr. B. Balt*

in and by *my* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents *am* well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full

and just sum of *Three Thousand* Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the *6th* Series of the *Installment*

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if *I*

fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that piece, parcel or lot of land, in Greenville Township,

Greenville County, South Carolina, known as Lot No. 8, Block A, of the property formerly owned by the Melville Land Company of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East side of Sumner Street, 366.625 feet from the Southeast corner of Sumner Street and Arlington Avenue (formerly Garlington Street); thence S. 16-20 W. 52.375 feet to a point, lot No. 9; thence with the North line of last mentioned lot S. 73-50 E. 192.55 feet to a point on the west side of a 20 foot alley; thence with line of said Alley N. 17 E. 51.17 feet to the corner of lot No. 7; thence with line of lot No. 7, N. 73-16 W. 193.1 feet to the beginning corner.
