Dollars, to be paid with interest

with interest thereon from the date thereof at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. V. V. McBarter, her heirs and assigns

being and situate in Dublin Township, Greenville
County, in the state aforesaid containing 161.93 acres
more or less, and has such shape, boundaries, courses
and distances, as is shown by plat of some made
by J. M. Cox, Surveyor, dated December 7, 1917 and being
bounded on the North by lands of J. M. Cooley; on the
east by lands of J. M. Cooley; on the south by lands
of J. M. Cooley and lands of J. C. Halliday; and on the
West by lands of Belton Power Company
