Dollars, to be paid six months from date

with interest thereon from the date of maturity at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George A. Norwood, his heirs and assigns, All those certain

lots in Greenville County and State aforesaid being Lots Nos. 13, 14 and 17 of Bates Heights, a subdivision of land shown by plat recorded in Plat Book F., page, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. Lots 13 and 17 front Bates Street, each 50 feet and have a depth of 150 feet. Lot 14 fronts Honour Street 50 feet and has a depth of 150 feet. These lots are a part of the land conveyed to Bates by J. Norwood and R. Mays Cleveland by deed dated November 4th, 1921 and recorded in Vol. 62, page 335, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
