and being in the state of South Carolina County and
Township of Greenville near Monaghan Mills and being known
as Riverside said lot being known and designated on a plat
of said lands made by Carter and Pringle Surveyors as
lot number 17 of Block "E" fronting fifty (50) feet on
Highlawn Avenue and having a depth of one hundred
and twenty-five (125) feet to an alley. Said plat recorded
in R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book
"A" at page 323 this being the same land conveyed to
George F. Alexander by Riverside Land Company by their
deed dated the 4th day of April 1912 recorded in R. M. C.
office in volume # 2 at page 80 and being the same
