with interest thereon from the 12th day of Feb 1923 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid as indicated above

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and being known and designated as  
Lot No. 9, as cut from tract No. 3, of the Overbrook subdivision, being more fully  
described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a point of joint corners of lots Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 and running thence  
S. 38.50 W. along line of No. 10, 214.5 feet to a point on Circle Street; thence along
