I, T.L. Henderson, of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said T.L. Henderson
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, an well and truly indebted to

Bessie T. Henderson
in the full and just sum of One thousand, nine hundred and fifty and no/100
Dollars, to be paid on the 15th, day of Sept. A.D. 1922

with interest thereon from the full date of making of at the rate of \$ per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$150.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said T.L. Henderson
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Bessie T. Henderson

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said T.L. Henderson
T.L. Henderson in hand well and truly paid by the said Bessie T. Henderson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie T. Henderson, her heirs and assigns forever: All that

certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the Town of Ft. Inn,
County and State aforesaid, containing one-half acre, more or less, and hath the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:
Bounded by lands of H.M. Stevens, Ernest Armstrong, Craig St., and W.D. Knight, beginning
at an iron pin on Craig St., and running thence N. 74-3/4 W. 32.25 to Armstrong's corner;
thence N. 64 W. 151 1/2 to an iron pin; thence S. 74-3/4 E. 3.25 to Main Street; thence along
said Street S. 64 E. 151-1/2 to the beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to
me by W.D. Knight by deed dated June 3rd, 1920, which deed is recorded in the R.H.C. Office
for Greenville in Book Vol. 71, page 251
