besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under the mortgage, as in and by the said note, reference

land lying and being in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid.
Beginning on a persimmon tree on west side of Buncombe Road and running about west 18
rods to a stake; thence N. 12 rods to stake N.E. 8 rods to a stake; thence with the
Buncombe Road 13 rods to the beginning corner, containing 1-1/2 acres, more or less.
~~And is further agreed between W.T. Bene and Annie Lindsey that when George Howard appears,
for trial at the March term of Court in Henderson County, this note and mortgage is to be
null and void and to be canceled from the records by W.T. Bene.~~
