with interest thereon from maturity of this mortgage at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part

State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Paris Mountain Township, containing  
twenty acres, more or less, and described by metes and bounds as:  
Beginning at a red oak near a fence (now gone) and running thence North 32-1/2 degrees East  
to a dogwood; thence North 45 degrees West nine and 30/100 chains to a rock; thence South  
32 degrees West twenty-two and 20/100 chains to a rock; thence South 50 degrees East nine  
and 30/100 chains to the beginning, adjoining the lands formerly belonging to Jno. Shockley,
