interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per centum

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan and Trust Company, All that certain piece,

parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of  
Greenville and in Greenville Township, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Calhoun Street at a point two hundred sixty  
feet North of Perry Avenue, corner of lot owned by T.L. Campbell and running thence with  
Campbells line South  $72\frac{1}{4}$  degrees East one hundred sixty-four feet and six inches to an  
iron pin; thence North  $17\frac{3}{4}$  degrees East fifty feet to an iron pin; thence North  $72\frac{1}{4}$   
degrees West one hundred sixty-four feet and six inches to an iron pin on Calhoun Street;  
thence with Calhoun Street South  $17\frac{3}{4}$  degrees West fifty feet to the beginning corner;  
being lot Number Six as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 497 in the R.M.C.
