until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note.....to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent of the
amount due upon said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Cuer Duncan.
