may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for the attorney's fee of

ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southeast corner of Frank Street and Hampton
Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-
Beginning at a stake on the east side of Hampton Avenue and the south side of Frank
Street, at the corner of said Street, and running thence S. 32-40 E. with Hampton Avenue
forty-five feet to a stake; thence N. 57 E. one hundred feet to a stake; thence N. 32-40
W. forty-five feet in a line parallel with Hampton Ave. to a stake on Frank Street; thence
