with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage): as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Willbanks

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, and  
having the following meters and bounds, to-wit; Beginning  
at an iron pin on the East side of the Old White Horse  
road, joint corner of the land of the grantor and D. D.  
Johnson's land and running thence S. 76-10 E. 170 feet to  
a stake; thence S. 9-30 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence N.  
76-10 W. 170 feet to a stake on the East side of the old  
White Horse road; thence with said road N. 9-30 E. 60 feet  
to the beginning corner.
