conditioned for the payment of the full and just principal sum of twenty-five hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00),

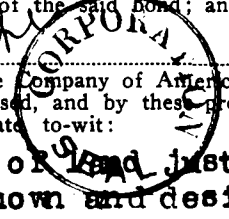
