All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Pendleton Street, and being more particularly described as follows, according to a plat thereof prepared by C.M.-Furman, Jr. September 14, 1922, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Pendleton Street, corner of Oak Lawn School lot, which point is two hundred (200') feet in a westerly direction from the northwest corner of the intersection of Pendleton Street and Ware Street, and running thence with the line of Oak Lawn School property N. 18° 45' W. 166.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 70° 52' W. 95 feet to a stake on Ansel property; thence with Ansel line S. 19° 35' W. 147.7 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Pendleton Street; thence with the line of Pendleton Street S. 70° 25' E. 91 feet to a stake; thence still with the line of Pendleton Street on a curve and in an easterly direction 109 feet to the beginning corner.
