DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Prudential Insurance Company of America* the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, on the south side of Crescent Avenue, being known as Lot No. 30 on a plat of Crescent Terrace, recorded in Plat Book "E", page 137, R.M.C. office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described according to a plat thereof prepared by G. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, on June 4, 1925, as follows, to-wit:-
Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of said Crescent Avenue at corner of lot owned by Tisdal and running thence S. 5° 41' E. 250 feet to a stake; thence N. 48° 40' E. 70 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 31; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 30 and 31, N. 5° 41' W. 250 feet to a stake on Crescent Avenue; thence with said Crescent Avenue S. 84° 40' W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
