and just sum of *Twenty five hundred 250* Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the *4th of July* Series of the *Instalment*

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if

All that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles from Greenville Courthouse, near the Laurens Road, known as Lot No. 18 on plat of Eastover, recorded in office of R.M.C. for said County in Plat Book F, page 42, and having the following courses and distances, according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Beechwood Avenue 180 feet Northwest of the intersection of Glen Street and Beechwood Avenue, also corner of lot No. 17, and running thence with line of lot No. 17, N. 18-05 E. 151.1 feet to iron pin in line of T.G. Glenn property; thence with line of Glenn property N. 72-27 W. 60 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 19; thence with line of said lot S. 18-05 W. 150.5 ft. to iron pin on Beechwood Avenue; thence with Beechwood Avenue S. 71-55 E. 60 feet to the beginning; being the same conveyed to R.R.
