AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being lot No. 21 (twenty-one) of the Overbrook Subdivision according to plat of said subdivision by H.Olin Jones, September 13, 1913, showing in detail all metes and bounds, and being of record in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book E, page 251; being the same conveyed to J.H. Howell by Anna L. Rowley by deed dated June 27, 1923, recorded in Book 82, page 117. Subject however to the conditions contained in the deed from Overbrook Land Company to R.J.
