WHEREAS, *I*, the said *A. P. Wilson*

in and by *my* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents *1888* well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full

and just sum of *Forty-five Hundred + no/100* Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the *5th & 7th* Series of the *Installment*

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if *I*

fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *A. P. Wilson*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*

the said *A. P. Wilson*

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, on

the north side of East Avenue, formerly Ann Street, in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 12 on a plat made by J.E. Serrine on October 1895, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at corner of lot No. 13 and running thence with East Avenue, formerly Ann Street, N. 80.15 E. 66 feet to the corner of lot No. 11; thence with line of lot No. 11, N. 11-30 W. 200 feet to corner on lot No. 18; thence with line of lot No. 18, S. 80.15 W. 66 feet to corner of lot No. 13; thence with line of lot No. 13, S. 11.30 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to J.W. Norwood by R.A. Monroe by his deed dated January 22nd, 1916, recorded in the Register of Mesne Conveyance Office for Greenville County in Vol. 38, page 575; the plat hereinabove referred to is of record in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book E, pages 37 and 38. Being the same lot of land conveyed to J.I. Westervelt by J.W. Norwood by his deed dated March 28th, 1917 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 46 page 199, and conveyed to me by J.I. Westervelt by his deed dated *30 Aug 1917* and recorded recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. *56*, page *56*.
